## **Explanation of Terms:**

Animal Control – stray animals brought in by an Animal Control Officer

Public Stray – stray animals brought in by a member of the public

Surrender – animals brought in by their owners who no longer wish to keep them

Quarantine – animals that are brought in for Rabies observation

Owner Request – animal brought in by owner requesting euthanasia or disposal

County – animals brought in from an unincorporated area of the City

Drop – animals that have been left at the shelter while the shelter is closed

Carry Over – animals remaining in the shelter from the previous year

RTO – animals returned to (claimed by) their owner

BHS –animals placed in the Butte Humane Society adoption program

Rescue – animals transferred to other rescue organizations

Transferred – animals transferred to another animal control agency (usually Butte County)

RTF - Returned to finder if not claimed by owner

Rehab – animals transferred to wildlife rehab center

Remaining – animals remaining at the shelter/in foster care at the end of the year
